

## **Grade 2 Cricket Team 2010**

Grade 2 cricket matches are played on Monday afternoons at St David's.

### **Please note the following points with regard to team selection:**

- Boys must attend practice regularly to be chosen for a team.
- We select as many players for each match as the opposing school is able to field.
- Teams are selected on a random basis with players being given equal opportunity to play in mixed ability teams.
- There are no set positions and the emphasis is on participation rather than competition so there are no official winners or losers.
- Players who display poor attitude, are badly behaved or disrespectful or are incorrectly dressed may be left out of a team.

## **Cricket Teams 2010 Under 9 – Open**

- Under 9 cricket matches are played on Thursday afternoons and occasionally on Saturday mornings.
- Under 10 cricket matches are played on Monday afternoons and occasionally on Saturday mornings.
- Under 11 cricket matches are played on Tuesday afternoons and occasionally on Saturday mornings
- First X1 and Second X1 cricket matches are played on Wednesday afternoons and occasionally on Saturday mornings.

### **Please note the following points with regard to team selection:**

- Boys must attend practice regularly to be chosen for a team.
- Only boys with the correct protective kit (hat, helmet, box and gloves) may play.
- Generally the more skilled players are selected for the A team. However, being selected in the A team at the start of the season does not guarantee that a boy will play in the A team throughout the season since recognition is given to other boys who improve their skills sufficiently to qualify.
- Players are usually selected for the B team on a rotational basis to ensure that all boys who attend practice are given the opportunity to play some matches.
- In selecting the teams, we make every effort to recognise ability and allow for maximum participation while at the same time remaining as competitive as possible and ensuring that the boys enjoy the game in a sporting manner.
- Players who display poor attitude, are badly behaved or disrespectful or are incorrectly dressed may be left out of a team.
- We endeavour to give all boys the opportunity to bat and bowl during the season and so we use a rotational batting line-up.

# Swimming Team 2010

## **Please note the following points with regard to team selection:**

- Children must attend practice regularly to be chosen for a team.
- In each age-group, a ladder is created on which children are listed from the fastest to the slowest in each stroke. The first two swimmers in each stroke are selected for the A team. However, being selected for the A team at the start of the season does not guarantee that a child will swim in the A team throughout the season since recognition is given to other children should they move up the ladder.
- Swimmers are usually selected for the B team on the basis of their ladder positions but where there are many children in a particular age-group, swimmers lower down the ladder are also given the opportunity to swim in a gala on a rotational basis.
- In selecting the teams, we make every effort to recognise ability and allow for maximum participation while at the same time remaining as competitive as possible.
- Swimmers who display poor attitude, are badly behaved or disrespectful or are incorrectly dressed may be left out of the team.
